



# CAD Decor – I level

a detailed program of a 1-day basic training for CAD Decor\*

1. Introduction and preparation for the training.
2. Basic information about the program.
3. Overview of features available in the 'Project selection' window
4. Analysis of the project which will be used during the training.
5. Creation of the new project file.
6. Navigation in the project, using various views.
7. Drawing a sketch and creating the walls on its basis.
8. Editing the drawn interior using the 'Walls editor'.
9. Inserting wall elements (such as basic bevels, standard doors and windows, parametric windows and additions: protrusions, niches and orifices).
10. Creating simple solids with straight edges using the 'Any elements' tool. (i. e. plaster-cardboard elements, concealed toilets, shelves, worktops and others).
11. Using the 'Posts and arc walls' tool, examples of application of different kinds of solids.
12. Insertion of interior design elements and edition of their parameters.
13. General information about the visualization mode.
14. Application and edition of textures.
15. Adding your own textures.
16. Application of ceramic tiles using the tools available in the 'Tiles' bar.
17. Edition of areas covered with tiles (i. e. creating niches, cutting orifices, moving tiles).
18. Inserting a mirror between tiles.
19. Application of decorative tiles.
20. Setting the parameters of optimization and reserve of tiles.
21. Valuation of ceramic tiles.
22. Generation of tiles documentation.
23. Setting the parameters of the light sources.
24. Saving the results of visualization as a JPG picture file.
25. Setting the parameters of a print-out of the tiles documentation.
26. Knowledge check and your own questions.
