Interior design valuation

1. Introductory remarks

Selecting the icon  "Interior items valuation", from the bar "Interiors 2" recalls window "Interior design elements", in a list of equipment elements used in the project (Illustration 1). The list of is constantly updated, so you can check or change the prices of the models used at any time.

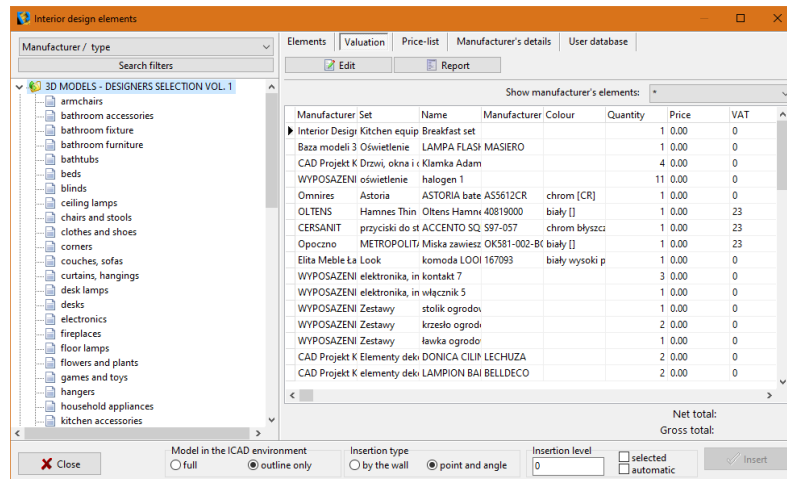




Illustration 1 Valuation of interior design elements

In the "Valuation" tab, there are options to edit the price and VAT rate for individual items - under the button  or by double-clicking on the item to be edited (Illustration 2), as well as the function of generating reports of used items .

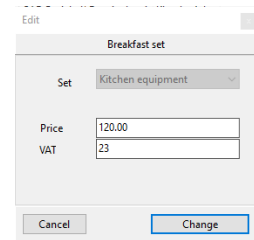



Illustration 2 Edit price and VAT

The total value of the inserted equipment (net and gross) is given at the bottom of the window .

After going to the "Price-list" (Illustration 3) tab and selecting the base in the left part of the window, the user gains access to the selected manufacturer's price list, where he can make his own changes. Also available in this tab are **price editing options** (individual and global) and "**Converter**", allowing you to change the currency and quickly convert prices across the database.

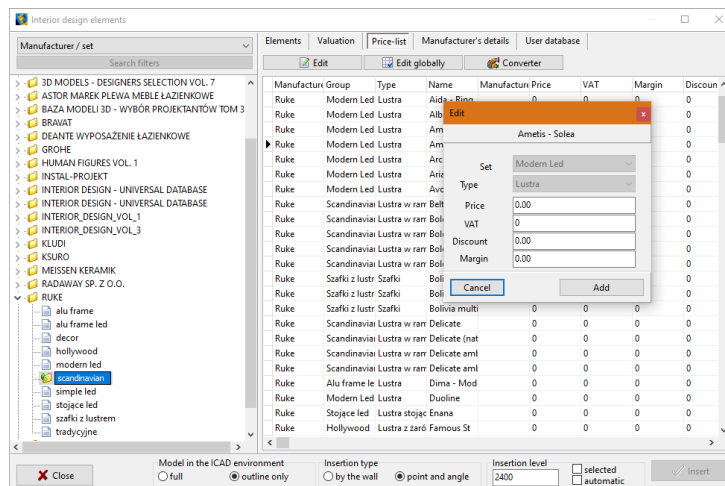



Illustration 3 Price list of the selected manufacturer - edit item

2. Edit valuation elements

The prices of the items used in the project can be changed freely in the current quote. To edit an item, double-click on the selected item or highlight it and select the "Edit" button  in the newly opened window (Illustration 4) you can enter the new price and VAT amount. The new values will be remembered by the program for the given project.





Illustration 4 Edit valuation items

3. Report generation

The valuation can be generated as a report and saved to disk in HTML format or printed. After selecting the "Report" button  a list of reports to choose from will be displayed (Illustration 5). A standard report is available, as well as selected manufacturer reports. After selecting the selected item from the list and clicking "Next>>" the report will be generated (Illustration 7 on the next page). In the next illustration, we show a preview of the report printout (Illustration 8).




Illustration 5 Selecting the type of report

4. Edit price list items of interior databases

In the "Price-list" tab, the user has access to view and edit the prices of items in the selected manufacturer's database. Individual editing involves selecting an item and clicking "Edit" button (or double-clicking with the left mouse button on the selected item) and entering new values in the "Edit" window (Illustration 6). After changing the price, VAT, discount or margin, click "Add". The new values will be remembered by the program.





Illustration 6 Individual editing of price list items

You can also globally change VAT, discount and margin for the entire price list or selected sets and item types. To do this, select the **"Global Edit"** button and in the new window, indicate the set, type or set and type contained therein, intended for bulk editing (Illustration 9, 10 and 11):

- if a set is selected, new values will be assigned for all elements in it;
- if a type is selected, the values will change for the elements belonging to it in all sets in the database;
- if both a set and a type are selected, the change will be made only for elements belonging to the indicated type and to the given set;
- if no set or type is selected, changes will be made for the entire price list.

After determining the extent of the changes to be made, enter the new values in the appropriate fields and confirm them by clicking **"Add"**. The program will ask you to confirm that the changes are to be saved in the database (Illustration 12).

5. Converter





Under the **"Converter"**  a function is available to quickly convert prices in the database to change the currency used (Illustration 13). When you select a new converter, the prices will be multiplied by it. The original prices are remembered by the program and can be restored by switching to the default converter with a value of 1. To create a new converter, click the icon  **"Add"** and enter the name and rate of the new currency by typing the value from the keyboard or using the buttons  and  (Illustration 14).

Databases can have predefined conversion factors. For example, if the prices in the database are given in Euro, the first time you open the "Price Converter" window, there will already be two entries in it: EUR = 1 and PLN = 4.45.

The following page shows an example of a price change using the converter (Illustration 15).

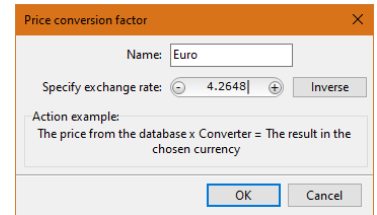


Illustration 14 Determining the conversion rate for the Euro

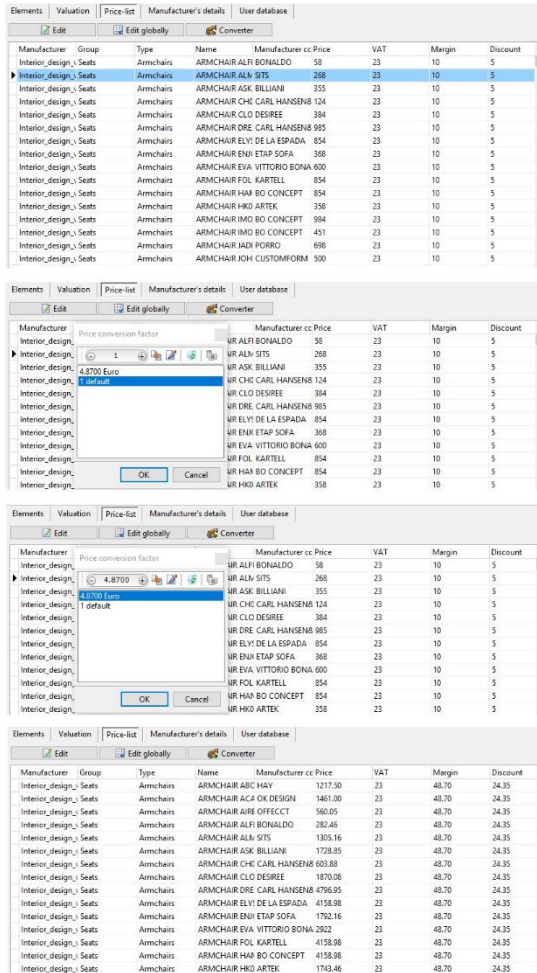




Illustration 15 Price list excerpt - prices before and after currency change

To define a new value for the converter, for example, when the currency exchange rate changes, select it by left-clicking and choosing the icon  "Change" (Illustration 16).

To delete a converter, select it and choose the icon  "Delete" or the [Delete] key on the keyboard. User-defined conversion factors are stored by the program for a given base. They should be defined separately for each base.

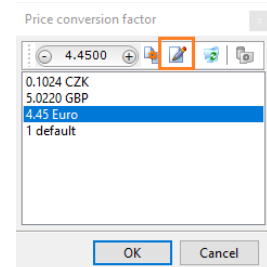


Illustration 16 Options of the window "Price converter factor"

1. Introductory remarks


[The valuation module for kitchen equipment is found exclusively in CAD Kitchens and CAD Decor Pro.](#)

The valuation module for cabinets and other kitchen interior design elements allows you to:

- comprehensive and detailed pricing and listing of all the elements that make up the kitchen design;
- adding your own elements and descriptions;
- summary of dimensions of objects in the project;
- project valuation and detailed prices given in net and gross amounts, with the possibility of introducing discounts and margins;
- saving the project quote as an XLS or CSV file;
- printing a report with the manufacturer's logo.

2. Appearance of the "Valuation" window

To start the quote, click on the icon  "Valuation", a window will open (Illustration 17).





2.1. Navigating the "Valuation" module

The left side of the dialog box is designed for selecting valuation elements. Clicking on the name of each group takes you to specific tabs with the valuation of individual elements (e.g. bodies, fronts, handles). The main part of the window contains a summary of the elements in each tab. These elements can be sorted. After selecting a specific selected model with a click, in the box at the bottom of the window it is possible to add its description (Illustration 18). In the bottom right corner of the window you will find two types of prices: the sum of net and gross prices of a specific group of elements, and the sum of net and gross prices of the entire project.

2.2. Icons of the "Valuation" window

The following table shows all the icons of the "Valuation" module window.

Icon	Function
 Add an element	- allows you to add a new item (from the price list) to created quote - adding is optional, dependent on the manufacturer's database that has been selected to create a given project;
 Change an element	- brings you to the cabinet edition window or price list editor window, allows you to change elements or process them;
 Delete an element	- removes the selected item from the project valuation;
 Change the price of an element in the current valuation	- allows you to change the price of an item only for the current project; - function also available under the button [F2] ;
 Change the discount for the customer	- allows you to change the discount for the selected item in the current quote; - function also available under the button [F3] ;
 Group elements with the same properties	- allows grouping of elements of one type; - function also called using the shortcut [Ctrl + G] ;
 Show database price	- displays prices stored in the manufacturer's database;
 Show studio price	- displays prices from the database including discounts;
 Show customer price	- displays prices from the base including discounts and margins;
 Show the price the customer price without VAT	- displays prices without VAT added (net);
 Currency exchange rate	- allows you to enter a new currency in which the project will be priced;
 Print a specification report of the current valuation	- allows you to print the current statement report - also under the [CTRL+P] command;
 Save as XLS/ CSV report	- allows you to save the price report to a file in XLS format (Microsoft Excel spreadsheet) or CSV format (format for storing data in text files, supported by most spreadsheets and database programs); (different worksheets may use different separators, so you are allowed to configure them - MS Office uses a comma, and Excell and Access uses a semicolon, according to regional settings for Poland)

3. Valuation of individual components - cabinets valuation

Cabinets sourced from manufacturer bases have standard prices assigned according to the manufacturer's price list (Illustration 19). Cabinets marked in red in the quote are cabinets of non-standard size (designations US size was changed by the user) or non-standard color (designations UC).

3.1. Editing cabinets in valuation

When editing cabinets, you can use active pricing icons, among others:

- „ Change the price of an element in the current valuation” (Illustration 20);
- „ Change the discount for the customer” (Illustration 22);
- „ Change an element” (Illustration 21).

3.2. Functions of the "Cabinet edition" window

- „Price change” - Changes the price of the cabinet in the current valuation;
- „Body/Front colour change” - options under "Cabinet content" (Illustration 23);
- „Cabinet content” – shows the components of a particular cabinet (Illustration 24);
- „Processing” - The second tab of the "Cabinet edition" window, where you can add cabinet components or assign cabinet processing (these functions are described in the next subsection);
- „Additional equipment” – Selecting this tab and the button "Add equipment" opens the "Price list Editor", where you can indicate the items to be added to the currently edited valuation item.

3.3. Contents of the window "Processing"

- „Add item processing”  - allows you to add a new item to the cabinet processing in the window shown next to it (Illustration 25);
- „Change the selected items”  - allows editing of an existing cabinet processing;
- „Delete selected items”  - removes processing item from valuation;
- „Move selected items up/down”  - moves an item up or down the list;
- „Save to the database as default for this element”  - processing item will always be added to this element in each project.

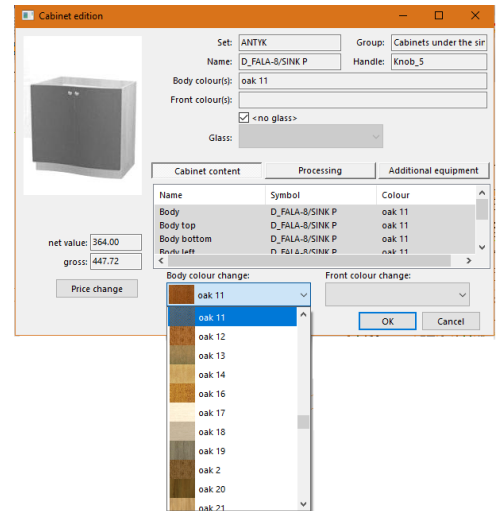


Illustration 23 Body color change

3.4. Contents of the "Additional equipment" window

"Additional equipment"- allows you to assign additional elements, (e.g. accessories), or operations (e.g. trimming, dimensional changes, etc.) to the cabinet, which are in the database. As was the case with the "Processing" tab, here you can also add, change, delete and permanently add equipment elements.

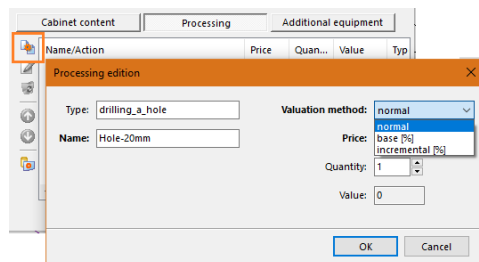



Illustration 25 Adding cabinet processing to the valuation

Note! in the same way you should use the "Prices" options in the case of other elements whose prices are taken directly from the ready price list: handles, worktops, posts and others.

4. Valuation of individual components - Worktops valuation

For some manufacturer bases, the pricing of worktops is automatic (Illustration 26). However, if the fields with worktop prices are blank, it means that you need to price the countertops yourself (Illustration 27). In order to price the worktops, it is necessary to:

- double-click with the left mouse button on the countertop to be valued - the user will be transferred to the abbreviated price list of the manufacturer's countertops (Illustration 28) (also available under the icon  after selecting the desired item on the list of worktops with a single click);

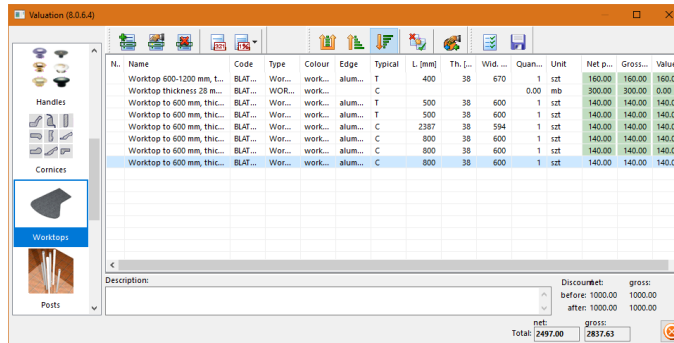


Illustration 26 Countertop valuation - manufacturer base with automatic countertop pricing

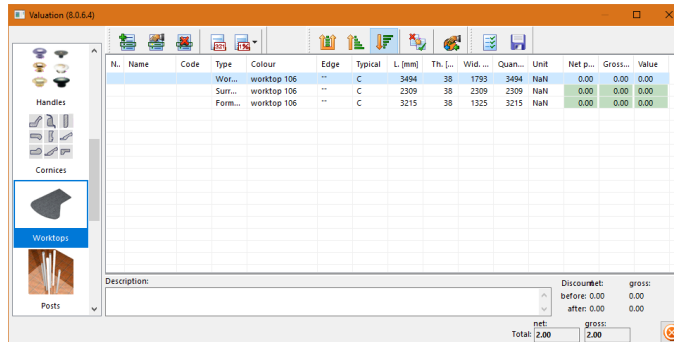


Illustration 27 Countertop valuation - base without automatic pricing, it is necessary to price countertops yourself

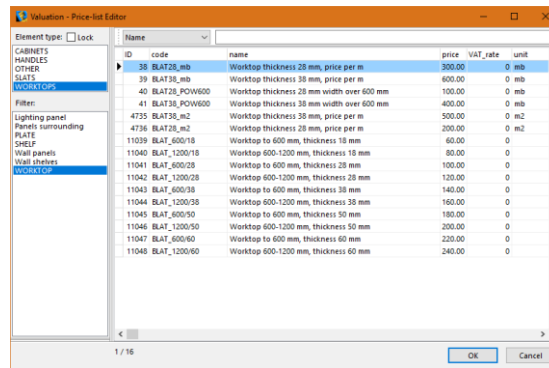


Illustration 28 Valuation - Price list

- in the price list, search for the appropriate item and click "OK.";
- this will take you to the "Worktop edition" window. (Illustration 29);
- in the newly opened window, you can perform the following actions:
 - change the parameters of the worktop (in the fields "Worktop dimensions");
 - replace an item from the price list (button "Open price list");
 - add worktop equipment (in the "Additional equipment" field);
 - add a worktop processing (in the field "Worktop processing");
 - change the price ("Price Change" button).

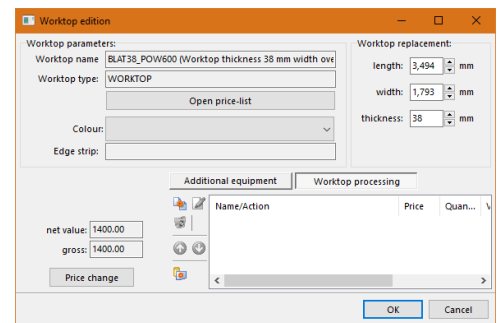


Illustration 29 Worktop edition

5. Valuation of individual components - „Kitchen Appliances and Fixture” and „Other”

Items under the "Kitchen Appliances and fixtures" tab usually have default manufacturer prices (Illustration 30). However, it is possible to edit and change these prices, on the same basis as in the previous described groups of items. You can also add a discount for the customer (Illustration 31).

6. Valuation Managers

The "Valuation Managers" window available under the icon (Illustration 32) contains all the completed project valuations:

- „active", that is the most recently created, current valuation,
- „inactive" saved previously, followed by new valuations for the same project, such as after replacing sets.

6.1. Functions of the "Valuation Manager" window

- „New valuation" - saves in the "Valuation Manager" window a new project valuation file;
- „Active" - activates an inactive valuation (by default, the last valuation of the project is always active);
- „Delete" - deletes valuations - individually or all previously saved ones;
- „Options" - opens a window to configure the valuation;
- „Price list" - allows you to go to the price list Editor;
- „Open valuation" - opens the highlighted project valuation;
- „Close" - closes the window "Managers valuations".

6.2. Functions of the "Valuation Options" window

In the "Valuation Options" window (available under the icon  "Options" in the "Valuation Managers" window) (Illustration 33), it is possible to enter the studio's data (name, address details, tax ID number) and select the valuation parameters that are to be taken into account when creating the cost estimate, by placing a in the corresponding field. You can save the data and settings as defaults (by selecting the "Save as Default" button) - in which case they will be in effect for each subsequent project quote. You can also restore the default settings by selecting the "Default" button.

Options that can be added to the quote are:

- inclusion of handles in the price of the cabinet;
- inclusion of bar holders in the price;
- adding the price of the plinth to the price of the cabinet;
- separate valuation for side plinths;
- cornices/skirting boards optimization;
- plinths optimization (pricing per unit);
- fronts valuation per m².






Illustration 33 „Valuation options" window

To access the price list of the kitchen cabinet base, click on the icon . This will then open the „Valuation - Price List Editor." window (Illustration 34).

7.1. Appearance of the "Valuation - Price List Editor" window

The field "Element type" allows you to display various elements that have been included in the pricing of a given database, such as: cabinets, worktops, fronts, slats, handles, fixtures and other elements. To move to the appropriate part of the price list, select a specific type of element. After indicating the group, you can also attach an additional filter (e.g. after selecting the type: slats, indicate the filter "masking" or "rim").
